Field Trips – the cost now includes the cost of fuel used.

OETT Grant – used to purchase 15 new smart boards and will be installed soon.

Connections – lead by Mrs. Nutter. This program is designed to help students not fall behind. If they are falling behind or have missed a homework assignment, the student will go to connections to complete the assignment as to not fall behind.

## **F. Committee Reports**

Fall Fundraiser – Karri Bigelow – The cookie dough will be here on October 23<sup>rd</sup> 2pm-6pm. There was \$26,189.50. Half of this is ours. \$14,000 was raised by the silent fundraiser last year. We are looking at a new or different fundraiser for next year. We must find a company that will allow us to profit 50%. All 4 Kids also provides great things for our Carnival.

Carnival – Robin Rose – We still need volunteers. We have many teenagers helping. If there are booths that are not covered, we will try to fill the holes with the rescue team. If holes remain, the booths will have to be closed at times. Dunk Tank – we need an OU, OSU and Texas fan willing to be dunked. We need flood lights for the playground area.

Teacher Baskets – Stephanie Lloyd – The Auction will be offering more live auction items this year and will have a new and improved check-out process. Buyers will be checking out by row. There will be items like front row tickets to Honor Choir concerts, Lunch with your favorite teacher, Lease the Marquette in front of the school for a week, Principal for a day.

Anyone who would like to bid will need to purchase a ticket (number) for \$1. There will be no names, only numbers.

El Chico - Mrs. Farris's class won the El Chico contest. The money raised by El Chico will be used to purchase airliners for the smart boards.

Box Tops - \$433 so far. Must turn the rest in by the end of October. We will get paid for what we turn in December.

Cinnamon Rolls - need volunteers to help bake on November 14<sup>th</sup>. Cinnamon rolls need to be picked up on November 15<sup>th</sup>.

Homerom Parents – Will be providing the Parent/Teacher Meal for the teachers coming up this month. We still need volunteers for Helping Hands.
